Barn Rules & Guidelines



1

Barn:

- Be Courteous and Respect other Owners and Horses.
- Theft will not be tolerated, and will be cause for immediate eviction
- All manure must immediately be picked up from parking lot, arenas, barn aisles, and throughout the barn
- Close all gates and doors, keep them closed
- Last person to leave is responsible for shutting off lights and closing doors.

Stall:

- Always clean up after yourself and animals daily
- Sweep up areas in front of your stall daily
- Water buckets should be emptied into wash bay or manure pile only, NOT in the arena or right out side any doors.
- Grain must be stored in a container with a lid
- Return all tools & barn equipment to it's designated area after each use
- Wheelbarrows must be emptied in manure pile after each use
- All stalls must be picked daily and stall floor DRY

Arena Use:

- Pick up manure after each arena use
- No un-supervised horses allowed in arena
- If you open the arena doors close them
- When you are done with the Arena lights shut them off.

Wash Bay:

- Wash Bay is for community use
- Clean up after yourself and your horse after each use.
- Do **NOT** wash grain, hay, manure, or mud down the drain in the Wash Bay
- Water buckets may be dumped in the Wash Bay

Hay Storage:

- A maximum of two square bales are to be stored on barn-provided pallets in front of your stall
- No round bales are allowed

Dogs:

- Dogs must be current on all vet recommended vaccines
- All dogs must be on a leash and supervised

Parking Lot:

- No horses are allowed to be tied to trailers unattended in parking lot
- Trailers are to be parked neatly and as Hawk Stables assigned
- Do **NOT** park trailers or vehicles on grass or anywhere other than graveled parking lot
- No personal vehicles are to be stored on the premises at any time
- Do not block any access roads or door to barn at any time

Turn Out:

- All horses must be brought in by 10pm
- No horse is allowed to stay out over night
- No grain is allowed in the outside turn-outs hay only

Riding:

- All Horse Owners, family members, and visitors must sign riding release form
- No other horse is, in any way, to be ridden or handled without the permission from that Owner
- No riding on neighbors property
- It is suggested that anyone under the age of 18 wear an ASTM/SEI Certified horse riding helmet
